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## 1.3.1 Institution integrates crosscutting issues relevant to Professional Ethics, Gender, Human Values, Environment and Sustainability into the Curriculum

**Professional Ethics:** In addition to other things, the institute focuses on educating professional ethics. academics to the students. Topics like research technique offer guidelines for the proper use of statistics in research while adhering to strict ethical guidelines. prescription drugs A course on jurisprudence covers the legal aspects of the ban on the sale of tainted, counterfeit and mislabelled medications that instil moral principles in the production process, medicine and cosmetics distribution and sales. Another course that upholds moral principles in gaining and maintaining society's trust is quality assurance. Communication ethics between patients, healthcare providers, and society are guided by moral duties and virtues through A course on communication skills is required as part of the curriculum. The fields of pharmaceutical product development and pharmaceutical regulatory affairs handle legal requirements and chemists' professional responsibilities with due regard for the welfare of society. Other courses include Employability Skill Development and Perspective of Quality Control and Quality Assurance in Pharma Industry help students learn professional ethics.

**2. Gender:** Gender equality ensures that all people have an equal chance to realise their human rights and to advance and profit from social, cultural, and economic advancement. The institute encourages gender parity in the classroom through the use of gender-neutral vocabulary, interactive lessons involving all students, and the division of pupils into boy and female groups for group discussions. To advance gender equality, women's empowerment, and gender sensitization, we host a variety of events. In order to raise awareness of gender parity, we host guest lectures, seminars, or workshops in honour of International Women's Day. Gender equality promoted equal opportunities, rights, and It is the duty of all genders to influence their own lives and advance societal progress. Group student participation in practical's, seminars, conferences, poster presentations, and research projects is also encouraged.

**3.Human Values:** Content outside of the syllabus is incorporated into a curriculum that maps programme outcomes, such as chemists and society, and upholds human values in order to create effective outcome-based education. We are planning a number of guest lectures to highlight the importance of the pharmacy profession in the healthcare system, as well as guest sessions to help students understand their roles as pharmacists in the advancement of society. Human values were also taught in courses like pharmacy practice and communication skills. Schoolgirls from the communities are also the target of awareness efforts regarding health issues, sanitary pad use, and hygiene.

**4. Environment and Sustainability:** We host a number of seminars and talks on topics such as water conservation, using polymers as renewable resources, and using green and sustainable methods in pharmaceutical chemistry in order to raise students' understanding of environmental sustainability. Additionally, the organisation is a big proponent of solar lamp use and tree



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planting on college campuses. The institute also encourages the use of online platforms for academic records in order to reduce paperwork. Ecosystem preservation is also aided by green chemistry initiatives, the recovery and reuse of organic solvents in research, and the recycling of water through the use of pumps in the condensation process.



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
